Heard Sri Prabhav Srivastava, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Rupesh Tiwari, learned Standing Counsel for the State respondent.

By means of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, petitioner has assailed the order dated 6th February, 2026 passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Meerut, namely, Prescribed Authority dismissing the application of the petitioner for delivery of possession under Section 14 of SARFAESI Act, 2002.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that application has come to be rejected only on the ground that petitioner failed to annex copy of the registration of secured assets with Central Registry as required mandatorily under Section 26- D of the SARFAESI Act, 2002 . He further submits that secured assets are duly registered with Central Registry and document of this effect has been brought on record as annexure 8 of the paper book.

In the given facts and circumstances of the case when secured assets have been registered with central registry under Section 26 D of the SARFAESI Act, we are not able to sustain the order passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Meerut in our considered view, matter is required to be revisited by him. Accordingly, we quash the order passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Meerut dated 6th February, 2026 passed upon application filed by petitioner under Section 14 of SARFAESI Act, 2002. The application stands restored. We direct the prescribed authority to proceed afresh provided petitioner files an application annexing copy of the central registry in addition to the application that had filed under Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act, 2002 within a period of two weeks from today.
